New direction for chamber

CORRIMAL Chamber of Commerce is updating its look to reflect a new image.

Chamber president Wendy Fogarty said the group would be working with members in coming months to consider a new name.

Ms Fogarty said there had been overwhelming support for a new name, with a survey of 110 local businesses showing 88 per cent were in favour.

Executives would decide on the new name, which is expected to be revealed in March.

The chamber has also established sub-committees in neighbouring suburbs.

“For the first time we have established sub-committees in Woonona, Fairy Meadow and Bulli to ensure businesses in these suburbs have a dedicated voice within our chamber,” Ms Fogarty said.

The new sub-committees would give businesses in outly-

ing suburbs a chance to have their say.

The chamber would be getting a new look alongside a new name.

“We’ll be updating the website, promoting the chamber door-to-door and taking a look at the packages we already have in place,” she said.
